



Position Title: Dance Instructor

Program Overview:

We've provided quality arts education in the form of piano instruction for students since 1988 and introduced art/STEAM instruction in 2020. We are currently seeking qualified individuals to provide dance instruction to students in Sonoma County schools.

Location/Working Conditions:

Sonoma County K-8 Schools & Studio (Windsor). The majority of schools that we instruct at within Sonoma County, are located in Santa Rosa, Rohnert Park/Cotati, Petaluma and Windsor. Employee must have a reliable means of transportation.

Compensation: starting at \$26.00 per hour/part-time

Position Overview:

Instructor will guide students in the technique, performance, and choreography of dance. Classes will focus on a style of dance forms, such as hip-hop, break dancing or salsa in a class setting, either at school campuses or our studio in Windsor. Each weekly class is 45-50 minutes in duration, with up to 20 students per class. Classes are organized by age groups (i.e. TK/K, Grades 1st-2nd, Grades 3rd-5th & Grades 6-8). During each class, students will be lead through warm-ups, preparatory exercises to introduce and break down stylistic movement patterns, progressive exercises that address a dancers' physical capacity for the style of dance, choreographed routines, and a cool-down. Instructors will curate classes for the differing age groups and create adaptations as needed for students with limitations. The Dance Instructor will contribute to the lesson plan and will provide clear direction, oversight, group instructions and one-on-one assistance to students as needed.

Strong leadership skills, experience working with youth of varying/diverse abilities, passionate about teaching and enriching through the arts within the community, effective communicator and strong problem solving skills, a positive mentor, good collaborator, punctual with good time management, self-sufficient and reliable.
