



Position Title: Assistant STEAM Instructor

We've provided quality enrichment in the form of piano instruction for students since 1988 and introduced STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics) instruction in 2020. We are currently seeking qualified individuals to provide arts instruction to students throughout Sonoma County.

Location/Working Conditions: Sonoma County K-8 Schools & Studio (Windsor). The majority of the schools that we instruct at within Sonoma County, are located in Santa Rosa, Rohnert Park/Cotati, and Petaluma. Employee must have a reliable means of transportation.

Position overview: Assistant STEAM Instructors aid students through a variety of art projects in a group class setting led by the lead STEAM Instructor. Classes are held either at school campuses for after school enrichment or studio in Windsor. Each weekly class is 30-50 minutes in duration, with up to 12 students per class. Classes are organized by age groups (i.e. TK/K, Grades 1st-2nd, Grades 3rd-5th & Grades 6-8). During each class, students will work on a set project that is appropriately curated for their age group. Students will work with various mediums to enhance their familiarity with STEAM components. Some projects will require students to work independently, while others will require collaboration and teaming. The Assistant STEAM Instructor will help students carry out the project as needed, escort students to and from art lessons to on campus child care (if applicable), support in maintaining structure in a group setting, and aid the STEAM Instructor in completing tasks as needed during class time.

Qualifications/Skills: Experience working with youth of varying/diverse abilities, passionate about teaching and enriching art within the community, effective communicator and strong problem solving skills, a positive mentor, good collaborator, punctual with good time management, background in art making (all mediums encouraged), self-sufficient and reliable.
